## Recycling around the World


New statistics give a view of recycling around the world. Here are three of the countries in the report.

#### **Switzerland**

The Swiss score well at recycling. With so many different types of recycling bins, local people only have to throw away a few household items. For example, they recycle 80% of their plastic bottles. That's much higher than other countries in Europe with plastic recycling levels of only between 24-40%.
